

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON REPORT OF PROPERTIES SUBJECT TO SEWER SERVICE CHARGES IN THE CRESTLINE SANITATION DISTRICT, PAYMENT OF WHICH IS DELINQUENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 AND PRIOR FISCAL YEARS.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Thursday, June 11, 2026 at 3:00 p.m. in the Crestline Sanitation District's Conference Room, 24516 Lake Drive, Crestline, CA, a public hearing will be held before the Board of Directors, acting in its capacity as the governing body of Crestline Sanitation District, on the report of delinquent charges.

The report contains a description of each parcel of real property for which the payment of sewer service charges for fiscal year 2025-2026 and any prior fiscal year is delinquent and states the amount of such delinquency for each such parcel. Said report is prepared pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 5470 et seq., and District ordinances.

At the time and place above stated, the Board of Directors will hear and consider all objections or protests, if any to said report and may continue the hearing from time to time. Upon conclusion of the hearing, the Board of Directors may adopt, revise or reduce any charge, and will make its determination upon each charge as described in said report, and thereafter will confirm the report by resolution. Those charges set forth in said report which are so confirmed will be placed upon the tax bill for fiscal year 2026-2027 for the real property to which such charges relate.

Any interested person desiring to make oral protest against the report, or any portion thereof, may do so by appearing at the hearing and requesting to be heard. Any person desiring to make a written protest may do so by written communication filed with the Board of Directors Recording Secretary at PO Box 3395, Crestline, CA 92325-3395, not later than the hour set for hearing on the report or by submission of said communication to the Board of Directors during the course of said hearing. A protest relating to the delinquent charge for a particular parcel of real property may be submitted only by the owner of such property and shall identify the property to which the protest relates, including the Assessor's Parcel Number for such property.

A copy of the report is available for public inspection prior to the hearing at the office of the Board of Directors Recording Secretary, Crestline Sanitation District Office, 24516 Lake Drive, Crestline, CA 92325.
